

Brackenbury Education and Community Hub - BEACH - Survey

This survey seeks to establish the level and nature of demand on Portland for the proposed community hub. This is needed as evidence to support grant funding applications.

To be located at the Brackenbury Infant School site in Underhill, a short level walk from the No.1 bus-stop, the BEACH Portland will provide:

a new larger location for Allsorts Nursery Brackenbury, enabling Allsorts to expand their provision to include day-care for babies and toddlers and parent and toddler sessions; a new home for the food bank ; a venue in Fortuneswell for activities for older residents, including lunches; an internet café, with assistance, providing computer and scanning facilities for residents who do not have these facilities; adult education courses in skills for the workplace (IT, literacy, numeracy etc); parenting skills sessions; a drop-in centre for young persons; a hall and a studio/classroom for hire to the community and service providers; other spaces for rent/hire to the community and service providers as need arises; a community green space; offices for Portland Town Council.
